The Secretary General of the United Nations has received a communication from the Secretary-General of Chile, dated 20 September 1974, in which he refers to article 84, paragraph 1, of the Convention on the High Seas, which provides that the service of the Chilean Navy is to be maintained at a level of 1:2.000.000. With regard to the point of the straight baselines, the following points defined by the straight baselines are referred to local datum Chart No. 1 of the United Nations, dated 29 September 1974, (Second Edition) and are shown in the attached map. The straight baselines of Chile are shown in the attached map.

The present document is the result of the work done by your Department in accordance with the commitment to the United Nations by Chile, in the communication of 20 September 1974, and the Zone Notification of 20 September 1974.

“The Republic of Chile reserves its rights according to its preliminary submission to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf, dated 8 May 2009, concerning its continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles, pursuant to Article 76 of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea”.
