The United Nations Office of Counter Tenorism, through the United Nations Counter Tenorism Centre, has worked in full gran over the past year to meet the capacity building meets of Member States and regional organizations, always, at their request.

In 2018 under the overall direction and guidance of Mr. Voronkov as UNCCT Executive Director; we implemented 43 capacity building programmes and projects across all four pillars of the United Nations Clobal Counter Tenorism Strategy, inclose collaboration with Clobal Counter Tenorism Coordination Compact entities

We provided capacity building support to 61 Member States and reached over 2600 individuals. This support included the delivery of 63 capacity building workshaps and activities directly benefiting approximately 1,545 individuals, and the organization of 13 outleach events with the participation of over 1,000 participants

UNCCT also supported the development of seven (7) key publications, including on supporting victions' associations in Africa and the Middle East; compliance with human rights legal standards related to screening of individuals at borders, the development of national and regional plans of action to prevent violent extremism as and when conducive to tenorism, and the responsible use of biometrics in counter tenorism, in collaboration with CTED and the Biometrics Institute

This represents a significant expansion of our implementation volume, which impressed 65% since the establishment of the United Nations Office of Courter Tenorism in 2017.

Werecertly finalized the 2018 Annual Report that provides a comprehensive overview of curcapacity building assistance and financial performance for the reporting year. A print version of this report will be sent to all Pernament Missions later this month as part of curcamain ment to full transparency. We are also upgrading curve baite and will upload the Annual Report, as well as relevant information from curcapated yreports, to this vebrite.

The Centre introduced this programme to OSCE, IOM and UNODC to explore cooperation, and briefed Member States on the 'UN Compendium of Recommended Practices for the Responsible Use and
