Sustainable Development Goals and targets

57. Concluding an inclusive, process-oriented intergovernmental negotiations/ and based on the proposal of the Open Working Group on Sustainable Development Goals¹⁵ which includes a candidate list of 17 goals and targets which have been agreed.

58. The Sustainable Development Goals and targets are integrated and indivisible/ global in nature and universal/ taking into account different national realities/ capacities and levels of development and respecting national policies and priorities. Targets are defined as aspirational and global/ with each Government setting its own national targets guided by the global level of ambition but taking into account national circumstances. Each Government will also decide on these aspirational and global targets should be incorporated into national planning

- 1.1 By 2030, eradicate extreme poverty (currently less than \$1.25 a day)
- 1.2 By 2030, reduce at least by half the proportion of men, women and children of all ages living in poverty in all its dimensions according to national definitions
