

Statement by Mr. Qasim Aziz (Pakistan), Coordinator,
introducing draft resolution A/C.6/76/L.12 on behalf of the Bureau

Mr./Madam Chair,

On behalf of the Bureau, I have the honor to introduce the text of the draft resolution entitled 'Criminal accountability of United Nations officials and experts on mission', contained in document A/C.6/76/L.12.

The draft resolution contained in document A/C.6/76/L.12 largely reiterates and further strengthens resolution 75/132 of 15 December 2020. In addition to technical amendments to the General

Assembly.

In terms of substantive changes, the text of operative paragraph 2 has been amended such that the General Assembly would recall all the relevant resolutions of the General Assembly on special measures for protection from sexual exploitation and abuse and on United Nations action on sexual exploitation and abuse, in addition to the relevant report of the Secretary-General and an evaluation report by the Office of Internal Oversight Services that was issued this year.

Turning now to some of the technical amendments, in preambular paragraph 22, the General Assembly would call its decision that, bearing in mind its resolutions 62/63 and 70/114, the consideration of the report of the Group of
