



Article 6 — Prevention and repression of misuse

1. The States Parties shall take all appropriate measures to prevent, investigate and punish acts of violence against a woman which constitute discrimination against her on the basis of her sex, and shall ensure that such acts are recognized as offenses under their national law, whether or not such acts result in violence against the victim or a violation of her basic human rights.

2.
