



4. On 1 November 2012, the Secretary-General filed his answer to Ms. Christensen's

appeal.

5. The Judgment in the Simmons case was issued on 12 September 2012, after Ms.

Christensen had filed her appeal. The Secretary-General, in his answer to Ms.

Christensen's appeal, explicitly refers to Ms. Christensen's motion and discusses Simmons

in relation to Ms. Christensen's case. Under these circumstances, I decide to grant Ms.

Christensen's motion and direct the Registrar to add said Judgment as part of Ms.

Christensen's appeal.

6. Since the Secretary-General has by now filed his answer which includes references

to the Simmons case, his request for an extension of time to file his answer has become

moot.
