4. On 9 February 2022, the appellant filed a motion for withdrawal of appeal. The Commissioner's general filing of his comments on the motion, dated 14 February 2022, in which he presented no objection thereto.

5. Article 141bis of the NPT Rules of Procedure allows the President of the NPT to make an order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties. The Appeals Tribunal has consistently held that a party may withdraw an appeal simply because it is not necessary to provide any further justification.²

6. The appeal is set to be set down for hearing, the appellant is legally represented, and the respondent does not oppose its withdrawal.
