

STATEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE GROUP OF 77 AND CHINA BY THE PLURINATIONAL STATE OF BOLIVIA, AT THE SECOND ROUND OF SUBSTANTIVE INFORMAL SESSION OF THE PREPARATORY PROCESS FOR THE THIRD INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON FINANCING FOR DEVELOPMENT ON LEARNING FROM PARTNERSHIPS (New York, 12 December 2014)
